TO THE GRADUATING CLASS OF 1979

As you will be the last class to graduate in the Seventies, it seems appropriate first to look back at what characterizes the two decades which have shaped your educational background; and second, to look forward to determine what role you as privileged educated leaders must play in the remaining two decades of the 20th Century.

Out of the struggles of the Sixties, those contradictions between the violence in society and the high idealism of students, came a new criterion for education. The limitations of the traditional basics in education became apparent and a new set of 3 R's for higher education were established -- Rights, Revolutions and Responsibilities.

Rights -- the human rights demonstrations protesting the bomb, war, and discrimination gradually made society aware that opportunities for a university education were not only the democratic but the human right of every individual.

Revolution -- the political revolutions followed by youth and student revolutions and ultimately by the women's revolution established a new sense of what was relevant subject matter, and who were to be the eligible recipients of traditional university education.

Responsibility -- the expansion of curriculum and the demands for higher education coming from a broader segment of society necessitated the responsibility of providing a concept of continuing not continuous education

With these 3 R's as part of your educational background, what then becomes your obligation to the future? Rights and revolutions demand concurrent responsibility. You must go forward involved and ready to serve those less fortunate than yourselves.

Corresponding, then, to the 3 R's of your past experience are the 3 C's of your future in a changing global community -- Consciousness, Connections and Commitment.


Consciousness -- heightened awareness of the needs and rights of others must be developed and maintained.

Connections -- theories about life and society must be translated into action. What you know must be integrated with what you do.

Commitment -- accumulation of knowledge which has made possible your graduation is meaningful only as you commit yourself to being a life-long learner and giver.

Graduation is not an end; it is a new beginning. Ahead of you is the opportunity to achieve a new vision for a new age global community which demands men and women who as equal partners continue the search for new holistic life styles.

## UNIVERSITY MOTTO

The university motto is “Veritas Ad Deum Ducit” which is translated as “Truth Leads To God”.

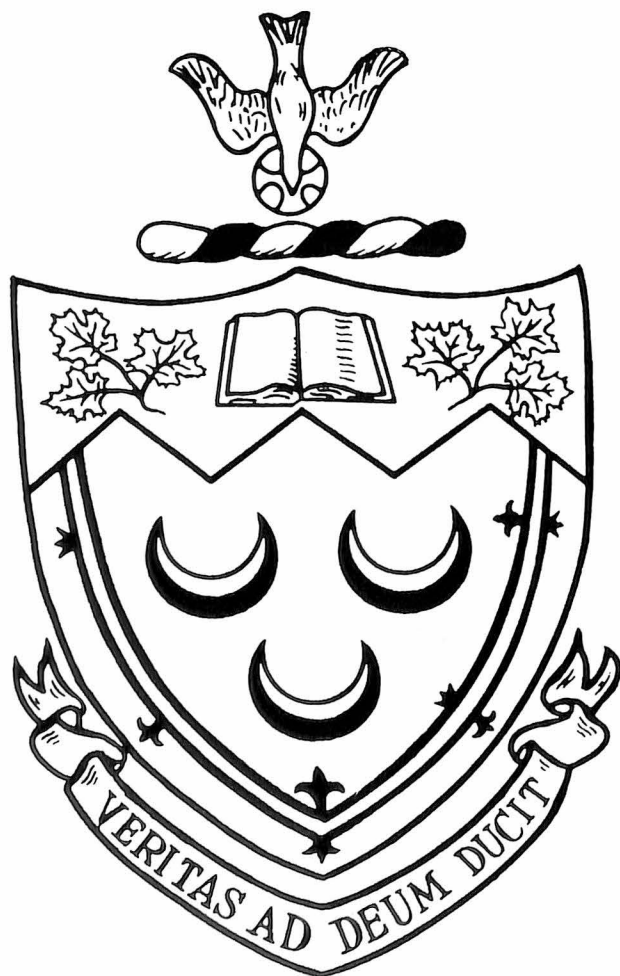
The motto asserts the religious concern which has inspired the foundations of the university.

## COAT OF ARMS

The coats of arms of the university is based on the coat of arms of Blessed Elizabeth Seton, foundress of the congregation of the Sisters of Charity. It bears three silver crescents of the Seton Arms within a “treasure”, the same one that is found in the coat of arms of the Province of Nova Scotia. Thus both the foundress of the order whose members operate the university and the Province of Nova Scotia are represented.

The three peaks on the shield signify the name of the university, “Mount Saint Vincent”. On the upper portion of the shield is the book of learning, between the maple leaves — the emblem of Canada. The dove above the wreath symbolizes the Holy Spirit, indicating that knowledge is the only means to wisdom, the highest gift of God.

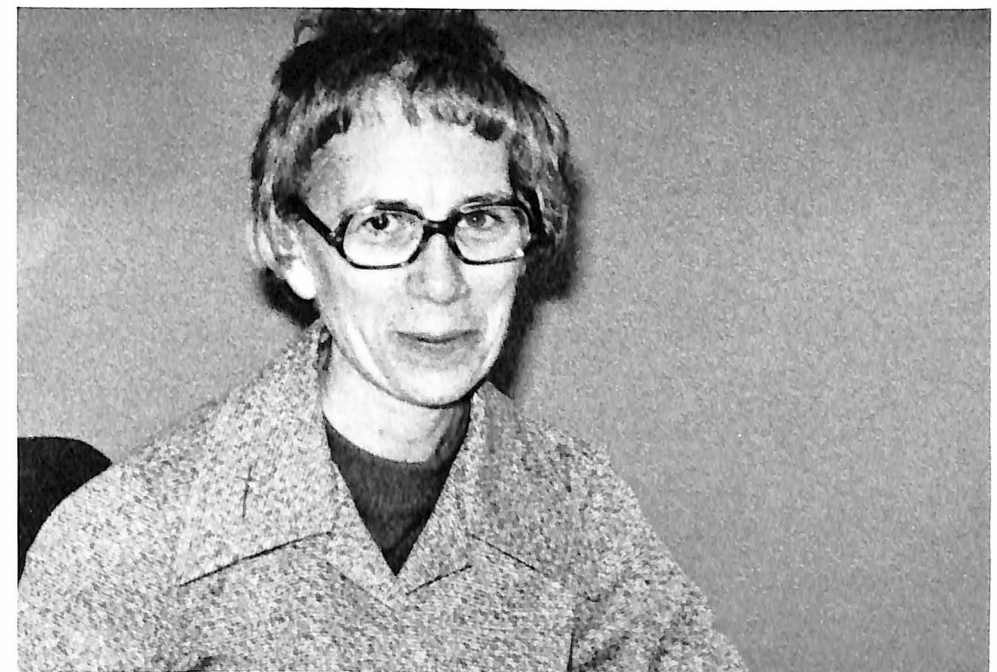
The colors of the shield are blue and gold — gold symbolizing the Divinity of our Lord and the blue for Our Blessed Lady. The periphery of the coat of arms is colors of royal blue and azure, the dual blues of Mount Saint Vincent University.



## DEDICATION

Sister Mary Evelyn Fitzgerald has been teaching some segment of the Mount Saint Vincent Community — Academy, College and University — since 1933. She served as Chairman of the Chemistry/Physics Department from its inception until 1977, and for several years was the only member of the chemistry department. A founding member of the new College in Evaristus after the 1951 fire, Sister was involved in the planning and membership of almost every committee on campus and is at present a member of the Mount Saint Vincent University Senate

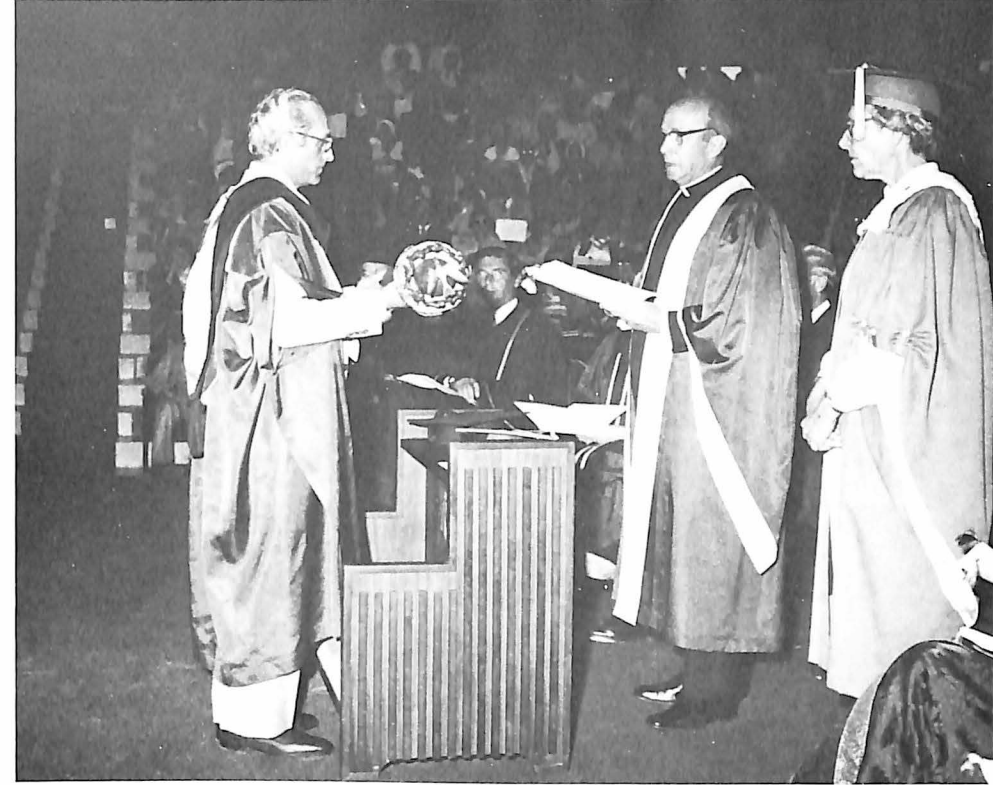


# INSTALLATION ' 78

VICE-CHANCELLOR ON SEPTEMBER 30th.

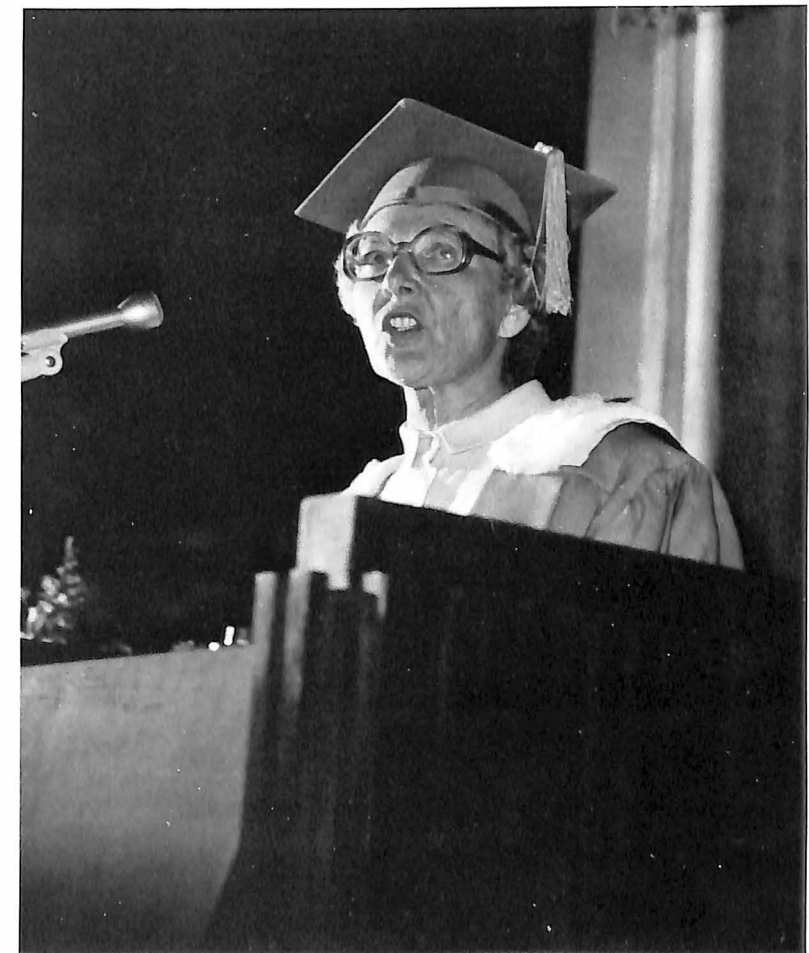

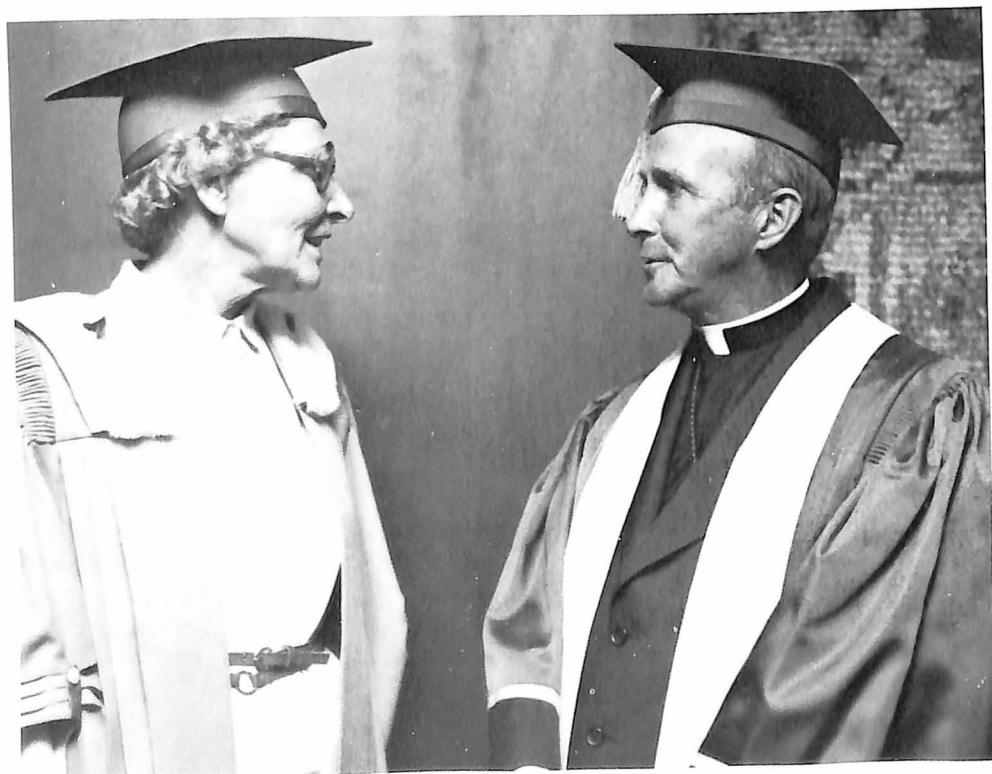
As the newly installed President, Dr. E. Margaret Fulton addresses the Mount for the first time, noting the potential of the University and its uniqueness.



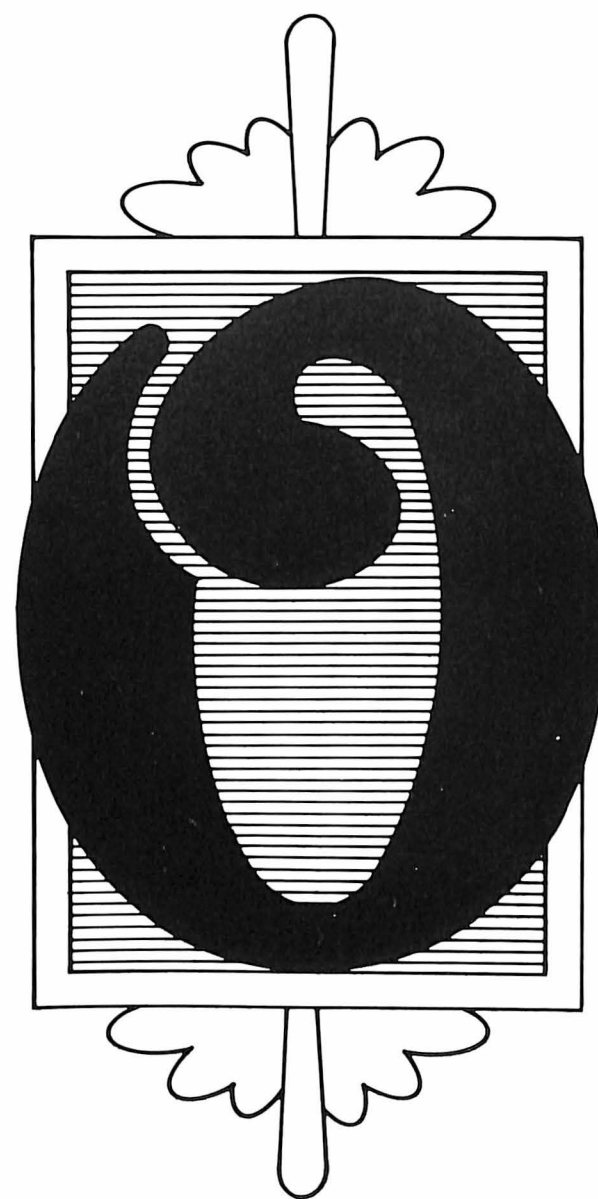

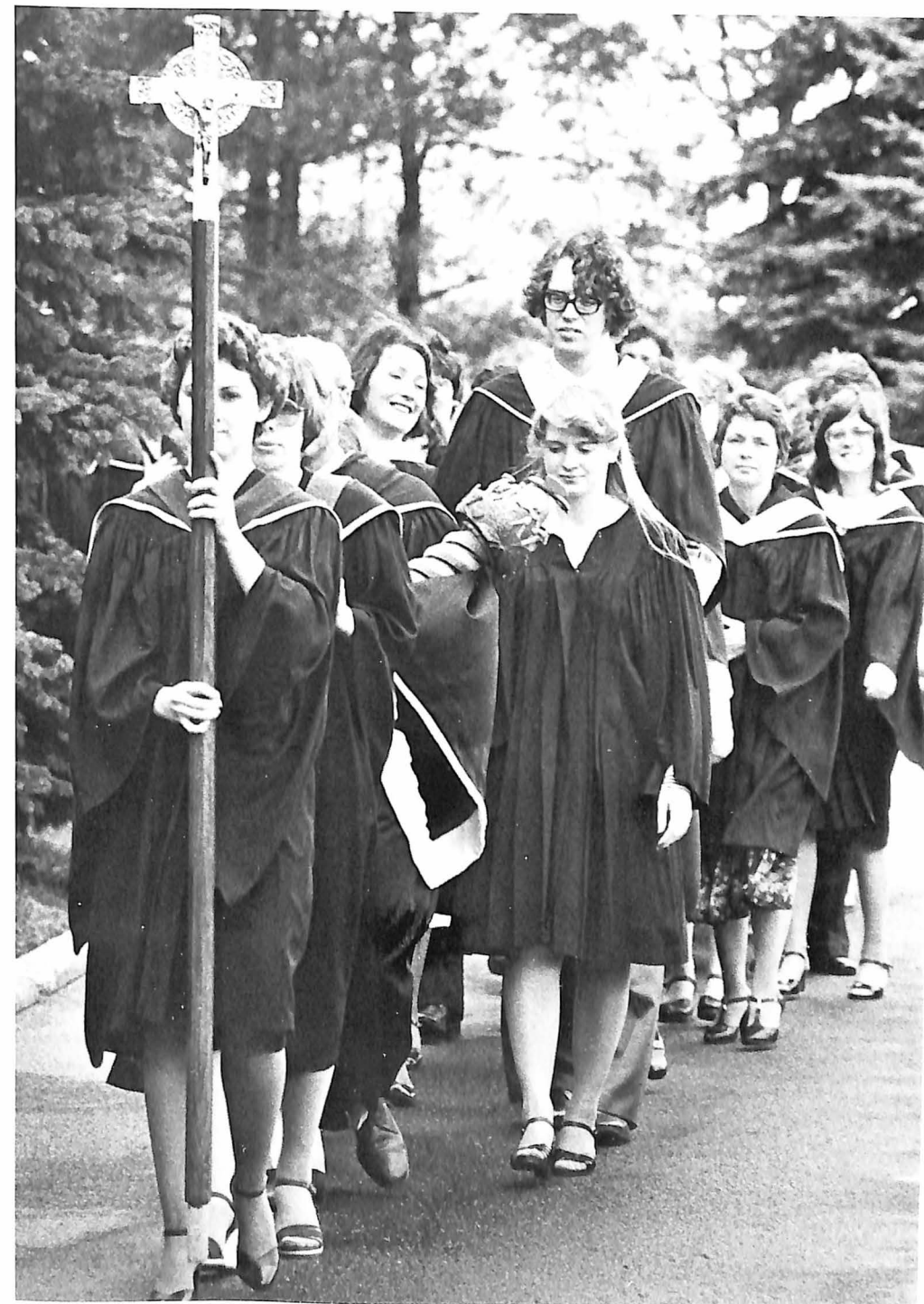




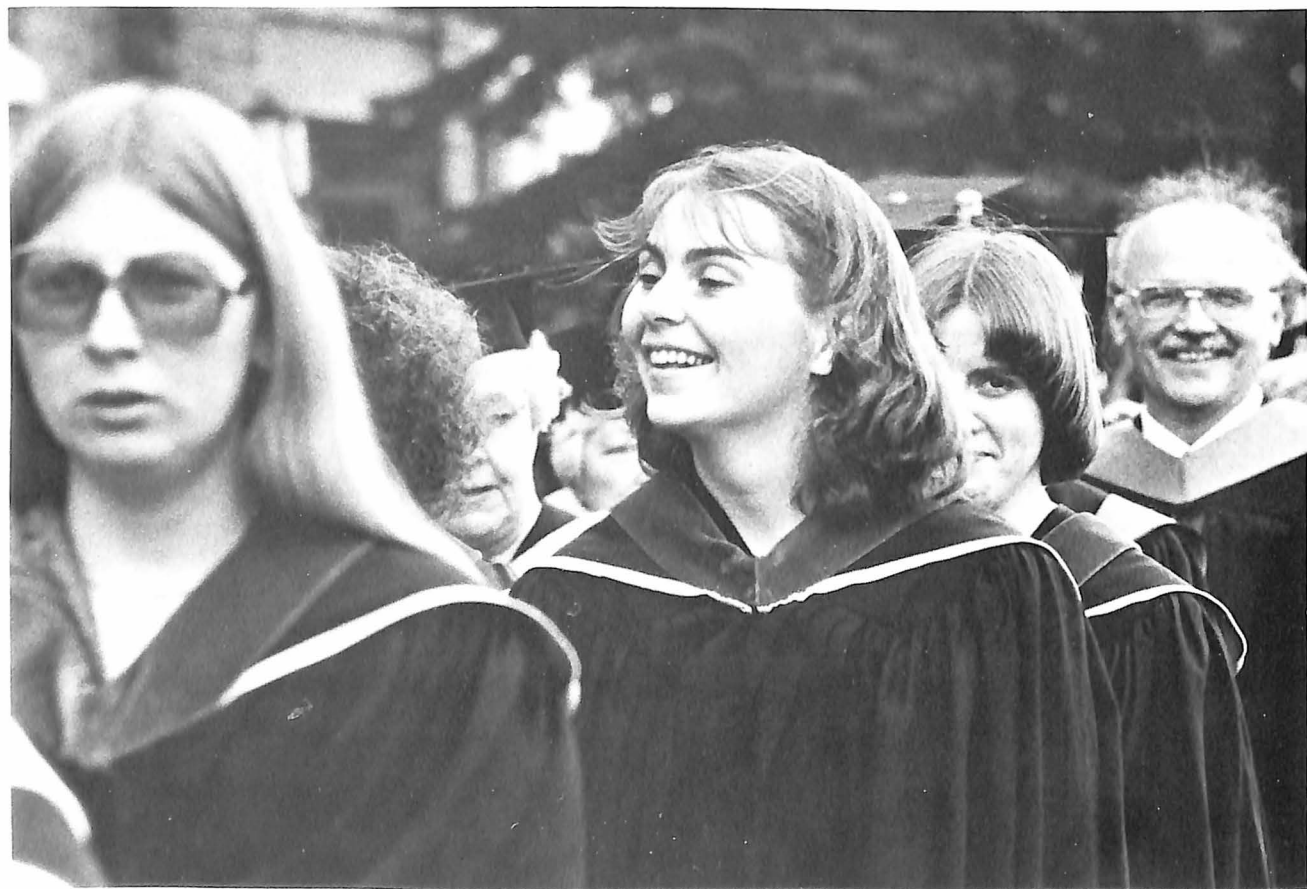




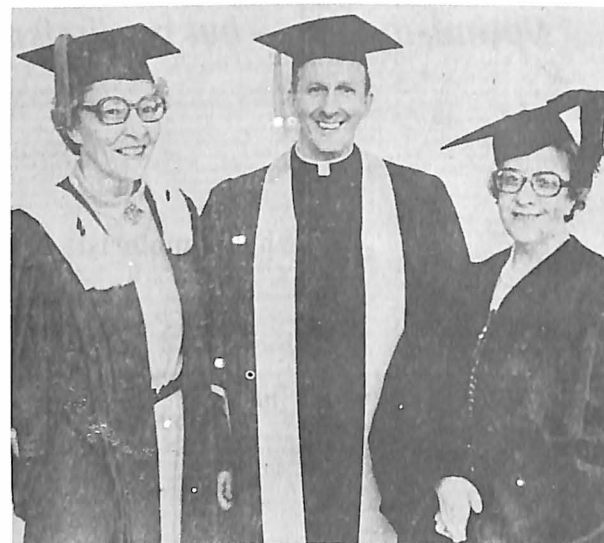
## BACCALAUREATE MASS
