## Women, art and politics subject of upcoming conference

Dr. Marguerite Andersen, the Mount's Distinguished Chair in Women's Studies, is organizing a Conference on Women, Art and Politics for Friday and Saturday, Nov. 18 and 19.

A panel, "Voicing Dissent", will launch the conference Nov. 18 at 8 p.m. at

the Nova Scotia College of Art and Design (NSCAD). The panel will be chaired by Wilma Needham, NSCAD faculty member. Saturday's workshops and presentations will be held on the Mount Campus, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. in the Seton Academic Centre. Giving presentations will be Dr. Mary O'Brien, gerontology chair, on Hildegard of Bingen, a medieval nun and political artist/poet, and Dr. Josette Deleas-Matthews, modern languages faculty, on French filmmaker Agnès Varda. The conference will also feature works and talks by Nova Scotia women artists.

"The conference will deal with political activities in the name of feminism and social change," comments Dr. Andersen. She says that it will offer a global view, yet highlight the local perspective through Nova Scotia artists and other participants.

Dr. Andersen explains that the Conference began in response to positive feedback on about Language and Sex: Differences in Tone, a regional conference which she organized for the Mount's Institute for the Study of Women last February.

The Conference on Women, Art and Politics is sponsored by the Mount's Institute for the Study of Women. Admission is free but advance registration is required for those wishing lunch (\$3) on Saturday.

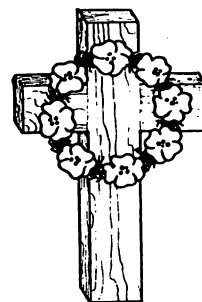

A 3-1 win over Kings College on Oct. 30 secured the Nova Scotia College Conference (NSCC) women's soccer championship for the Mount. This is the third year in a row that the Mount's women's soccer team has held the title, and athletics/recreation assistant Patsy Pike credits team spirit as the key. "We really work together well. We play as a team, rather than depend upon any single players. That makes us stronger than other teams."

Pike describes the game against Kings as "great action...really exciting. All the girls played really well." It was an especially big day for Terry Canning who

scored all three Mount goals. Also, at the awards ceremony after the game, the Mount's Caroline Rogers, Pam Bussey and Lisa Gomes were named to the NSCC all-star team. Rogers was also named 1988 winner of the Gerry LeBlanc Award for outstanding leadership on and off the field.

On Oct. 23 the Mount's women's cross-country running team of Melanie Claude, Patti Strople, Carol Tickner and Brenda MacGillvary placed first in the NSCC championships for the fourth consecutive year. The men's cross-country running team, in its first year, placed second in its NSCC league.
