Giant cod sinks naval fleet, again!

Acting Rear Admiral, Private Karl Buttinsky, yesterday confirmed reports that the entire Canadian Naval Fleet was wiped out by a giant, killer cod. The fleet, comprised of a rowboat, two rubber dinghies and a yellow submarine, was annihilated while sitting in Halifax Harbour for repairs. Although no one has claimed responsibility for the attack, officials speculate the Newfoundland Liberation Army is to blame.

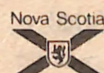

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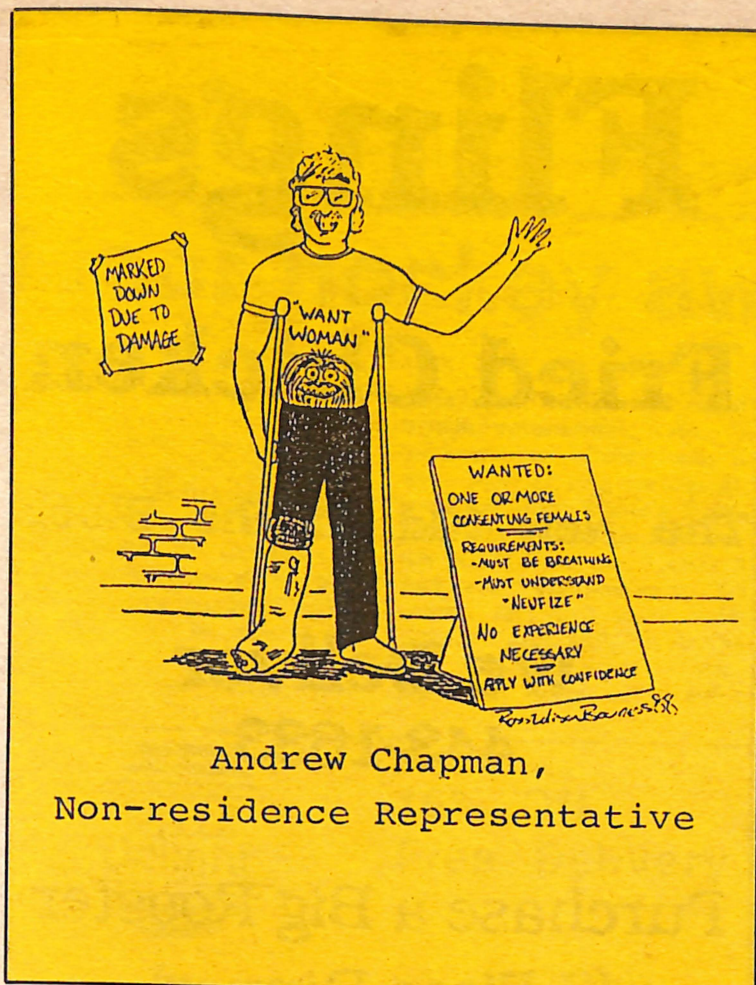
