

MSVU ATHLETICS & RECREATION 2018-2019 REVIEW







The Mount Mystics had a "banner" year as we celebrated winning three Atlantic Collegiate Athletic Association Championships in Women's Soccer, Women's Basketball and Women's Volleyball. All three teams represented the Mount and the ACAA at the CCAA National Championships travelling across the country to compete with the very best – Soccer in Coquitlam, BC; Basketball in Quebec City, Que and Volleyball in Welland, Ontario. An amazing experience for our student athletes and coaches.

Our Men's Basketball team and Men's Soccer team also had outstanding years qualifying for the ACAA Championships and making it to semifinal play. Both teams are very young and the future looks very bright for these talented squads. Our cross country running team doubled in participant numbers and we were able to field a full team in both the men's and women's division in almost every meet. At the ACAA Championships our Women's Cross Country team placed an impressive third place.

Fourteen of our student athletes were named to ACAA All Conference teams. Cross Country Coach Matthias Mueller and Women's Basketball Coach Mark Forward were named ACAA Coach of the Year. A third consecutive year for Coach Forward – Mark was also honored by being named CCAA Women's Basketball Coach of the Year – a huge compliment to Coach Forward and the Mount.

Our 2018-2019 Athletics program felt special. EVERY team truly reflected throughout their seasons, their value of respect, hard work, empathy for others and team work. Excellence in the sport they love and their academics are what our teams strive for, and the mutual feeling of family and working together was the path these teams chose to reach those goals. Well done!

In 2018 – 2019 Mount Campus Rec had students involved and having fun all year long. Popularly attended Paint Nights were held each month. Mount Campus Rec, MSVU Geek Squad Society and MSVU Paranormal Society hosted the first ever Mount-Con event in October, where we brought out our inner geeks! The Rec Society partnered with the Meal Exchange Society for the Annual Trick Or Eat event on Halloween canvasing the community in support of Feed Nova Scotia; this year they broke the Mount's record with 28 boxes and 18 bags of food, and raising over a thousand dollars. We also partnered with Hike NS and launched a new Mood Walks program; getting participants active in nature and boosting their mood. The Rec Society conducted their first ever Christmas Card Campaign; collecting holiday cards with handwritten greetings and delivering them to local nursing homes and hospitals. We rang in the holiday season with the 11th Annual Grinch's Gala, selling out in just one day! On Caritas Day the Rec Society held their 2nd Annual BackPack GiveBack collecting items, packing them into backpacks and delivering them to local shelters. Many braved the winter with Mount Campus Rec to have a blast on the Annual Ski Martock trip. March may have gone out like a lamb, but it came in with the 15th Annual Mardi Gras Super Party that turned

the Rosaria Lobby into New Orleans and attracted 200 partiers. Our Intramural programs ran every Thursday night including Basketball, Volleyball and Futsal. Mount Cup Residence Challenge had a successful year with participation from all three residences, in monthly events such as Dodgeball, Fall Fest, Gingerbread House Contest and more! Birch 2 was victorious in taking home the grand prize!







It has been a very busy but positive year for the Mount Fitness Centre. In the Fall we did a remodel in the Conditioning Centre that included: freshly painted walls, a re-organization of space to optimize the floorplan and create better flow,two new TRX Suspension training units, the StairMaster Gauntlet (a beast of a step mill!) and a variety of small equipment such as kettlebells, heavy bands and resistance loops. We also added 4 high-powered wall fans in both the Exercise Studio and the Conditioning Centre which has helped to keep air circulating and cooling the space.

To enhance our Fitness Centre offerings in 2018/19 we introduced 10 and 20 Class Passes (in January) for Group Fitness, we added new fitness class times on Monday & Wednesday 6:15am, Tuesday & Thursday 1:00pm and a Sunday morning class in Fall & Winter and introduced new class styles: Mpowered, Recover, Ballet Body, Yoga Fusion & Circuit. For Active Living we added new programs such as African Dance, Zumba Step Fusion, Stretch Lab, and Agility Training and provided 30 minute TRX training sessions for only \$15!

Personal Training specials offered throughout the year has helped double the number of members utilizing this service.

Our social media presence has continued to grow with the help of Katherine Khorovets and Courtney Smith. This dynamic duo are the stars of "What's up Wednesday - with Kat & Courtney". This weekly feature enhanced promotion and engagement with our students.
